

Acceptable Documents Guide

Overview

USCIS accepts one document from List A, or a combination of one from List B and one from List C. See the current Form I-9 Lists of Acceptable Documents on [USCIS.gov](https://uscis.gov) for the authoritative reference.

List A — identity and employment authorization

- U.S. Passport or U.S. Passport Card
- Permanent Resident Card (Form I-551)
- Employment Authorization Document (Form I-766)
- Foreign passport with I-94 and endorsement (in limited cases)

List B — identity only

- Driver's license or ID card issued by a U.S. state
- School ID card with photograph
- Voter registration card
- U.S. Military card or draft record

List C — employment authorization only

- Unrestricted U.S. Social Security card
- U.S. birth certificate (original or certified copy)
- Certification of Report of Birth issued by the U.S. Department of State
- Employment authorization document issued by DHS

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
